WAYS TO MAKE A PLANNED GIFT

Bequests	Name MPUMC in your will; designate an amount, percentage, or residual value of your estate.
Real Estate / Property	A bequeath of land or residence to MPUMC.
Life Insurance	Name our church as a beneficiary or gift a policy to our church.
Stocks / Gifts of Securities	Contribute non cash charitable gifts including shares and bonds.
Retirement Assets	Name our church as a beneficiary of your retirement plan.
IRA Trust Rollover	Anyone who is 70 ^{1/2} or older can transfer IRA assets up to a total of \$100,000.
Charitable Remainder Trust	Annual income for the donor with the remainder specified for MPUMC.
